He has spent 24 years in Southern California working on structural earthquake engineering, forensic engineering, adaptive redevelopments of historic buildings, renovations, design and construction of new buildings.

Michael participated in several post-earthquake assessment and repair programs including an 8-month period facilitating the assessments of damaged structures in Port-au-Prince and surrounding communities due to the January 2010 earthquake in Haiti. Following this assignment he has relocated to New Zealand in 2011 to assist following the Canterbury Earthquakes with Engineers he met in Haiti.

He has worked now in New Zealand for 13 years on post-earthquake repairs and seismic upgrades of historic buildings including adaptive redevelopments of historic and brick buildings.
